- a. **Discussion and possible action** regarding approval of the subdivision of the former golf-course parcel previously rezoned by the Township.
- b. **Consideration of a Memorandum of Understanding** with the YMCA in support of its grant application to repair the Tri-Community Pool, carrying no financial obligation to the Township (previously approved by Harborcreek and Wesleyville).



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- c. **Discussion and possible action** regarding the conveyance of the former East Erie Suburban Recreation Authority parcel to the YMCA on terms materially similar to those approved by Wesleyville, the Township being a successor owner along with Harborcreek and Wesleyville.

- d. **Consideration of Resolution 2026-27** authorizing payment of the 2026 pension obligations based on the prior year's MMO and the state pension aid received in September.
- e. **Consideration of Resolution 2026-28** amending the Water Street Phase II and Phase III grant application to extend its terms up to the full cost of the potential project.
- f. **Consideration of Resolution 2026-29** accepting and allocating county aid received from PennDOT, at no cost to the Township.
- g. **Consideration of Ordinance 2026-2** establishing parking restrictions on Morse Street, prohibiting parking on school days from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. between Tyndall Avenue and Smithson Avenue.

- j. **Discussion and possible action** regarding the appointment of a member of the Police Department as Code Enforcement Official, with duties, compensation, and uniform kept separate from police work.
